



MEMO: ESSENTIAL CAREGIVERS

November 16, 2020

Important Information- Please review prior to visiting at Parkwood Mennonite Home

The Region of Waterloo has moved to orange alert status.

We are asking all essential caregivers to remain vigilant when visiting and at all other times. It is imperative that all essential visitors read and follow the guidelines below.

1. Maintain a social distance of 6 feet from all others (e.g. visitors, employees, other residents), except your resident.
2. Use hand sanitizer liberally and often.
3. Keep your mask on, covering your nose, mouth and chin at all times. Please do not bring anything to eat or drink while you visit.
4. Long Term Care Caregivers - When possible, remain in your resident's room or unit to limit exposure to others.
5. To maintain infection control best practises, do not enter employee areas such as the dining room serveries, laundry and clean linen areas, cleaning supply areas, offices etc. If you need something please ask a team member. You may need to wait – please be patient.
6. Essential Caregivers and Essential Visitors are now restricted to one person visiting at a time.
