As President and Chief Executive Officer, I am humbled to share 'this year in review' with you, as well as update you about the projects and new initiatives as we continue on our path.

First and foremost, I would like to thank two incredible people – Marion Good and Ed Nowak - for their service to Fairview Parkwood Communities as they finished their tenure with the Board of Directors in June.

Both served on several committees including the Executive Committee, Marion as the Board Chair and Ed as the Vice-Chair. Through their leadership, Fairview Parkwood Communities persevered through the pandemic, fostered growth at both campuses and positioned the organization to continue the journey to "Build a Community for All". Words cannot express my appreciation for your vision, expertise and dedication. Thank you.

As Marion and Ed complete their terms, we are pleased that Bob Shantz has been nominated to Board Chair and Brent Horst to Vice-Chair. We are grateful Ed is remaining with the Board as Co-Chair (non-voting).

I would also like to welcome Jennifer Gleeson to the Board of Directors. Jennifer brings a diverse background to the Board as an advocate for individuals with developmental disabilities, family and community health programs including her work with the Canadian Mental Health

I am also pleased to share new growth within Fairview Parkwood Communities. In September 2023, Fairview joined together with Craigwiel Gardens to establish a Shared Services Group. Financial support services were initiated in April and the Craigwiel Gardens Board of Directors has expanded the scope to include the full range of services including finance, administration, building management and care & services. We are excited to be working with the Craigwiel team as we start this new partnership.

I don't want to lose sight of the ongoing construction projects at Parkwood and Fairview. The Delphine and Lloyd Martin Apartments at Parkwood continue to be on schedule, with an anticipated opening in the spring of 2024. Fairview Seniors Community also celebrated the official ground breaking of the long-term care home expansion of 108 beds. When complete, the home will accommodate 192 residents. Construction has started and is anticipated to finish in spring 2026.
