Residents and team members were delighted to welcome **Prime Minister Justin Trudeau** to Parkwood on Friday, February 2, 2024. The Prime Minister was joined by Bardish Chaggar, MP, Waterloo, Karen Redman, Regional Chair of the Waterloo Region and Dorothy McCabe, Mayor of Waterloo to make an announcement related to federal funding for the region. It was an honour to have the Delphine and Lloyd Martin Apartments at Parkwood selected as the location because of its representation of 'Community at its Best'.

Prime Minister Trudeau and MP Chaggar also visited with Parkwood Suites' residents. This was an incredible day. Our sincere appreciation to MP Chaggar for her ongoing support. I share my gratitude with all those who made the fundraising, construction and opening of the Delphine and Lloyd Martin Apartments successful.

On behalf of the Capital Campaign Committee, I am pleased to share the **fundraising goal of \$7.5 million has been reached.** These funds helped support the construction of affordable housing units. To all of the congregations who participated in the Capital Campaign, your donations helped to make this goal a reality.

On March 6, 2024, the first residents were welcomed and new residents are moving in daily, adding a new vibrancy to the campus. We continue to be humbled by the overwhelming interest in the apartments and the many people who have selected Parkwood as their new home.

When you drive by the Fairview campus, you will notice many changes as the long-term care expansion moves forward. This is a complicated multiphase project with the construction taking place around the existing building while it continues to provide quality services. Completion is anticipated Winter 2026. When complete, the long-term care will be home to 192 residents.

As Fairview Parkwood Communities continues to grow, the team will expand as well with Marius Lamprecht as the new Chief Operations Officer within the Resource Team, and Devon Pierce as Director of Hospitality Services at Parkwood. You will learn more about them on page 3.

We are pleased to announce that Marius Lamprecht will be joining Fairview Parkwood Communities as the **Chief Operating Officer**.


